By Car

From the A1(M) take the A64 York/Scarborough road. From the A64 take the third exit for York, the A1079 Hull Road, and turn left towards York (Map 1). Drive for about half a mile, keeping in the left lane. Drive past the Park & Ride, on your left, and B&Q Warehouse, on your right, to a major roundabout; turning left (signposted University/Heslington/Science Park) (Map 2). Drive along that road until you reach an angular roundabout, passing a church on your right and a primary school on your left. At this roundabout turn right. Either follow the signs to York Science Park or drive 200 yards to the next roundabout; then turn right again. After the first building you will see Alcuin Way then the Science Park signs on the left.

The Innovation Centre is the first building on the left of the science park (Map 3), with the IC logo on the front of the building. This is shown on the Science Park layout map. Visitors may park anywhere in the Innovation, Bio or IT Centre car parks.

By rail

York is on the East Coast Main line with regular services from London King Cross, Edinburgh, Glasgow, Birmingham, Bristol, Leeds, Manchester, Newcastle, Nottingham and Liverpool.


By taxi


By air

The nearest international airport is Leeds/Bradford. Visitors can then travel to York by rail from Leeds railway station (approximately 25 minutes), or by road (approximately 50 minutes by taxi). There is also a direct rail-link from Manchester International Airport to York (approximately one hour).
